## Castrén & Snellman the Most Popular Law Firm Employer Among Finnish Law Students For the Third Year in a Row

Castrén & Snellman scored a hat-trick in The Universum Student Survey. Our firm was found to be the most popular law firm employer among Finnish law students for the third time in a row. The results of the survey were published on 5 May 2011 at the Universum Awards gala in Helsinki.

Our firm was the only law firm to make the top three employers, and placed third in the overall survey. The most popular employer in the survey was the Ministry of Justice, and the courts were the second most popular. A total of about 6,500 Finnish students participated in the survey, including about 330 law students.
